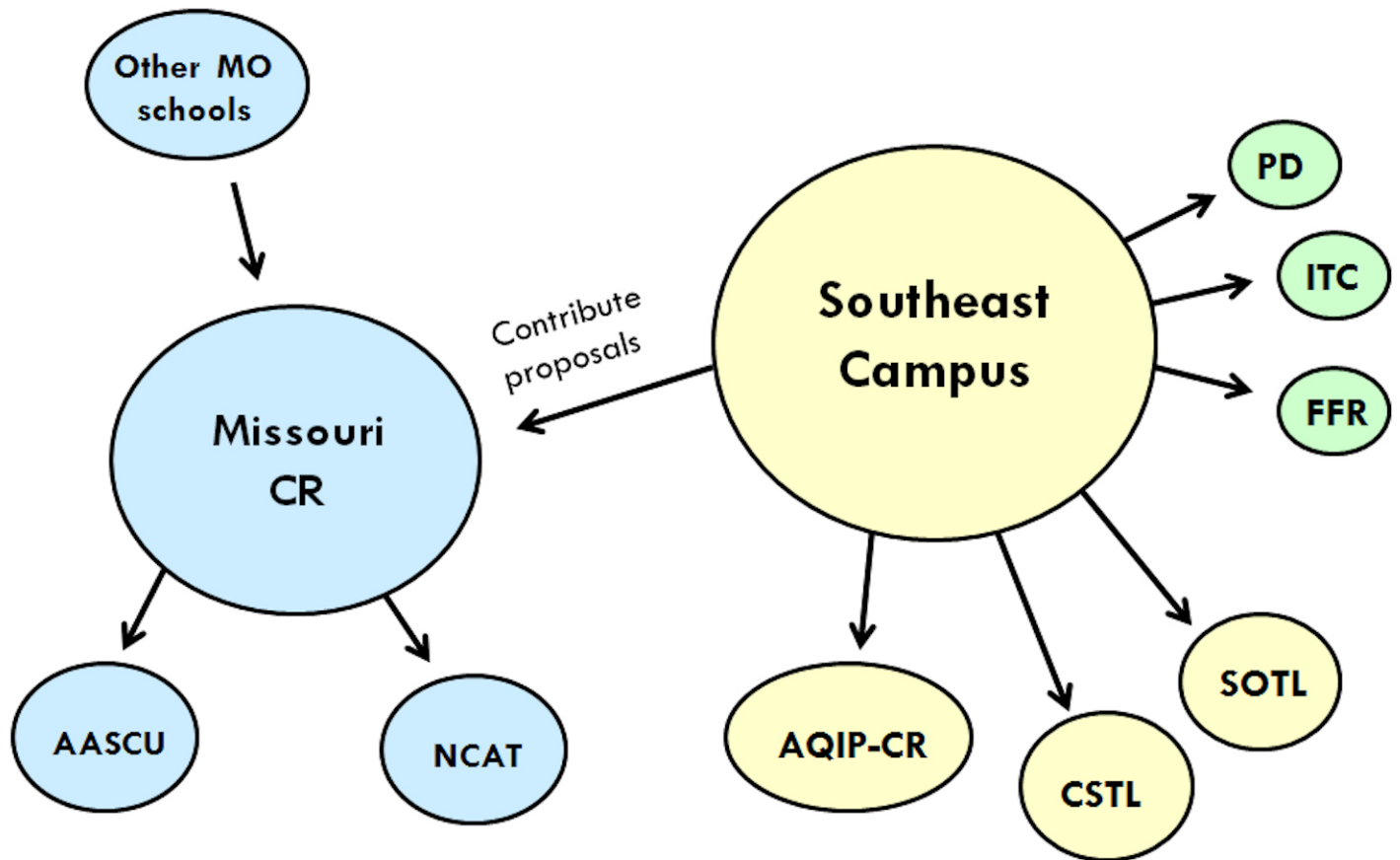


Opportunities in Course Redesign



AASCU & Next Generation Learning Challenge Grant

Statewide blended courses.
English composition, pre-algebra, other gen ed core courses.
Successful pre-proposal.
Full proposal submission soon.

Statewide Course Redesign Initiative

National Center for Academic Transformation program.
Proposals submitted to NCAT, one large enrollment undergraduate course per campus selected.
Statewide training session for teams from all 13 public 4-year universities in Missouri.
Required orientation workshop February 18 in Columbia for those interested in submitting a proposal.
Registration **deadline February 11, 2011**.
Follow-up required workshop April 8th for those planning to propose a course.
Example courses: AR112, BS108, CH185, EN100, EN140, MA134, PS103, PY101, SC105, SO102, US107.

Funding For Results (FFR)

Portion of FFR funds set aside specifically for Course Redesign related projects.
Second call of 2010-2011 recently closed.
Four Course Redesign projects funded in first call.
Watch for additional calls for proposals in 2011.

University Information Technology Committee

Portion of ITC funds set aside specifically for Course Redesign related projects.
Funding for technology supporting the Course Redesign process.
Call for proposals currently out. **Deadline February 4, 2011** to Dean or Vice President.

Professional Development Opportunities

Professional development funding for workshops, conferences and other activities supporting Course Redesign process at Southeast.

Course Redesign AQIP Action Project

18 courses redesigned Fall 2010 - Spring 2013.
Four semester development and implementation process.
Five courses under development in first round: EN100, MA101, PS103, UI100, US107.
Second round call for proposals now out. **Deadline February 22, 2011.**

Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (SoTL) Fellows Program

Ten projects funded each year.
Nearly 60 faculty to date have gone through the program.
Year long program helping faculty identify and turn classroom research into scholarly products.
\$1,000 in professional development funds available per SoTL Fellow.
This year Course Redesign projects are encouraged to apply for SoTL Fellows program.
Call for proposals now out. **Deadline April 1, 2011.**

Faculty Development and support.
Workshops, resources, consultations and other instructional support.
Faculty Innovators:
Faculty representatives from each college and school supporting the efforts of CSTL.
Currently focused on Course Redesign efforts and faculty development.
